Course Cancellation & Refund Policy

ORCGA reserves the right to cancel any course due to insufficient enrollment or other causes.

Participants who wish to withdraw from a course, **must provide ORCGA with written notification** (see below for details). Refunds as a result of withdrawal are processed according to the following criteria:

- At least ten (10) business days prior to the course start date:
 DPT 100: a full refund minus a \$50 administration fee;
 DPT 200: a full refund minus a \$50 administration fee and \$75 manual fee.
- Between three and nine (3-9) business days prior to the course start date:
 DPT 100: a 50% refund;
 DPT 200: a 50% refund minus \$75 manual fee.
- Withdrawal less than 3 business days before the start date of the course and no-shows: no refund will be provided.
 Registrants will receive, subject to approval from ORCGA, a course credit for withdrawal due to an emergency. The credit must be used within one year from the original course start date.
- Registrant substitutions may be made at any time prior to the start of the course.
